



TAKE YOUR TIME WHEN PACKING

Take steps to ensure moving day is as relaxed as possible for you & your pets.

To avoid panic, stretch out your moving prep time over several weeks.



GET TAGS & LEASHES FOR YOUR PETS

Create ID tags with your new home address & phone number.

Be sure your pet is wearing them during travel.



MAKE TRAVEL PLANS FOR YOUR PETS

If your move involves air travel:

Make reservations 1 month in advance.

Choose non-stop flights to avoid extra handling, climate & air-pressure changes.



VISIT YOUR PET'S VET BEFORE MOVING

2 weeks before moving:

Obtain a copy of pet's health records

Confirm pets are up-to-date on shots

Ask about any new state entry regulations



DON'T GO A CHANGIN' - MAINTAIN YOUR PET'S ROUTINE

Dogs & cats like to feel in control. They can exhibit behavioral changes or become ill if stressed.

Do your best to keep your pet's feeding & walking schedule the same before your move.



KEEP YOUR FURRY FRIENDS SAFE & COMFORTABLE

A few days before moving, select a small "pet room". Create a sign for the door that says "Pets: Do Not Open".

For a familiar smell, move their food bowls, carriers, beds & toys inside. Leave the carrier door open, so they adapt to them before travel.

Beds, pillows, towels, etc.



Plastics bags, scoops for dogs



Food & Water



Bowls, can opener & lids



Litterbox for cats



Paper towels for messes



Toys, chew bones & treats
